

**State of Illinois  
Recycling and Reuse Act  
January 1, 2012**

The new and improved electronic Recycling and Reuse Act becomes effective January 1, 2012. This new Illinois law bans the trashing of old electronics. The law calls for a first-time \$25 fine. The law also contains requirements for electronics manufacturers.

Therefore, the Village of Annawan will no longer pick up electronics placed with or in your trash.

Electronics are defined as anything with a cathode ray tube, or CRT, or a circuit board. Currently they are:

- TV's
- Computers
- Computer monitors
- Printers
- Keyboards
- Computer mice
- Scanners
- Fax machines
- Satellite receivers
- MP3 players (portable digital music players)
- Zip drives
- Video game consoles
- Digital converter boxes
- VCRs (video cassette recorders)
- Small-scale servers
- Cable receivers
- DVD recorders (digital video disc recorders)
